Background

- McMaster Libraries participate in a variety of OA publishing agreements, including Read & Publish, as well as tailored OA licenses.
- The Libraries' support manifests in waiving or discounting Article Processing Charges (APCs).
- Strategic promotional efforts focus on dissemination of high-level information.
- McMaster authors face challenges in navigating nuanced license terms and identifying eligible journals.

A central searchable platform that allows researchers to find journals where they can publish open access with article processing charges (APC) waived or reduced.



Information displayed:

- Journal title and imprint
- Payment options
- Licence types
- Publishing model


- To qualify for support the Corresponding Author must be affiliated with McMaster University. Use your @mcmaster.ca email.
- If prompted, select either the CRKN or OCUL Consortium to receive APC (Article Processing Charges) discounts.
- Who Pays? APCs are partially (e.g. 10%) or fully covered by the Library.
